Plymouth-Ann Arbor Elks Lodge #325 will be hosting our annual Southeast District Charitable Grant Fund (Gold Key) Golf Outing on Saturday, August 25<sup>th</sup>, at Hilltop Golf Course in Plymouth, MI.

This tournament funds our Gold Key charity, a 501c(3) recognized organization which provides scholarships for post-secondary education for Special Needs students. The scholarships are for a student that is physically challenged, currently eligible for special education services under the Federal guidelines, or as may be approved by the Gold Key Commission of the Michigan Elks Association. Students may be awarded up to \$2000.00 per year, for up to 4 years or \$8000 total award. Scholarships are intended to assist qualifying applicants in continuing their education by training past high school at either an accredited college, university or a licensed trade/vocational school, or with life skills to help them become self-respecting, self-reliant, and self-supporting members of society.

Currently, we are in the process of requesting donations for our outing prizes. In recognition of your generous donation, a sign including your company's name will be added to our "Thank You to the Following Companies" display board. In addition, a follow-up email to all the attendees will be accompanied by our prize donor list. This type of advertising has the potential to reach hundreds of Elks and friends throughout Southeast Michigan, and photos and sponsor lists appear on our State Association web page.
